Getting Started

1. What has been your closest encounter with Jesus?
2. Have you ever seen a dark, bleak situation turn into a life-giving, good situation?

Digging In

1. **Read Acts 9:32-35.** What is the result of Aeneas' healing? Look specifically at **verse 35**.
***Leader's Note:** The obvious thing is that he was healed and his life was transformed, but in addition to that, other people took notice, repented, and changed their lives as well.
2. **Read Acts 9:36-43.** What was the result of Tabitha's resurrection?
***Leader's Note:** Again, obviously Tabitha was brought to life, but all the Christians who were around were encouraged, and most importantly all the people of Joppa were saved!
3. Tabitha was resurrected from death. What does resurrection mean? What different aspects of resurrection are there? Look at **Romans 6:1-12** and **1 Corinthians 15:12-20**.

***Leader's Note:** Have a discussion about how all believers are spiritually resurrected from sin and death (**Romans**) and will one day be resurrected physically to reign with Christ in eternity future (**1 Cor.**).

Looking Around

1. What has Jesus done for you? Has he resurrected any part of your life?
 2. What could you do to show the people around you the change that's taken place in your life?
